



ARTHUR TOKLE

1922 Born in Norway

1947 Came to the US at the age of 25. Started his competitive career at Bear Mountain, NY; immediately recognized as class. He suffered from unfair comparisons to his late brother Torger, who blazed a starry trail in the American jumping scene in the early 40's.

1950, 1954, 1958 Member of the F.I.S. American ski team

Was an aggressive competitor who broke records established by his brother, and a Norge Ski Hill record at Fox River Grove, IL.

One of only three ski jumpers with a three-time winner record of the Winged Trophy of the Brattleboro Outing Club.

1951 & 1953 National Champion

1952 Member of the US Olympic team.

1960 Member of the US Olympic team at the age of 38.

Took up ski flying in Norway.

1960 – 1968 Served on the US Ski Association coaching staff, as special jumping coach for various Olympics.

1963 Considered this his finest season, at age 40, he won 12 out of 13 tourneys.
