US National Championships – 1977 placed 2nd place in Class A at Laconia NH.

1968 – While traveling in Norway, competed in various events in Junior Class, highlighted by 1^{st} place in Molde, Norway, 2^{nd} place in Meldal and Namsos, Norway.

1969-70 - Placed 11th in St. Moritz, Switzerland, and went on to compete in the 18th Annual Intersport Springer Tournee.
