Reuben Hamari (1927 – 2012) – Bio –

Reuben was born March 6, 1927 to Toivo and Hilda Hamari, the fourth of eight siblings, and grew up in Kingsford Heights MI. All spoke Finnish at home.



He began ski jumping by the age of eight, and represented the Red Wing junior club in regional competitions. By the age of 14, he had chalked up his first jumps at Pine Mountain.

In April of 1945, while a senior in high school, Reuben enlisted in the Navy. He was honorably discharged in July of 1946, and soon completed studies for his high school diploma.

At the beginning of the 1946/47 season he represented the Kiwanis Ski Club in Class B. After placing well in the first few tournaments, he was elevated to Class A in time for the Pine Mountain event in March. The significance of such an accomplishment is underscored by the fact that there were 151 competitors entered, 26 of them Kiwanis. He acquitted himself well, placing 3rd. Also significant is that Reuben was the first local Kiwanis jumper to be promoted to Class A.

Reuben competed for an incredible 17 years, 1947 through 1964. In his final tournament at Pine Mountain, he placed 4th in Veterans class.

The two next-youngest brothers, Allen and Roy also became very good Class A jumpers. Reuben also was an exceptional golfer and a very good downhill skier.

Reuben was probably unaware that he was a role model for numerous aspiring younger jumpers, quite a few of whom went on to become US Team members; looked up to as a stalwart individual who loved God and served his country; a rock-solid ski jumper, and known for his '51 Merc coupe. Accounts by those who experienced travel to tournaments in the coupe are that the car didn't stop to switch drivers – there was a way to do that on-the-fly. Neither were there rest stops – that's what windows were for.

He was a most pleasant individual; modest, unassuming, quiet and soft-spoken, but with a quick smile and a great sense of humor. His prowess on the ski hill was only second to his stature as an upright, hard-working, and humble family man.
