Eric grew up in Iron Mountain, MI, and competed for the local Kiwanis Ski Club.

1986 At age 13, took his first ride on Giant Pine Mountain Ski Jump, scoring a first place finish in the junior class and other impressive jumps throughout the weekend against an international field of competitors.

No young junior jumper has ever repeated that kind of performance on the largest K120 meter ski jump in America. The early win literally “jump started” an outstanding ski jumping career. His long stride and deep telemark landing was his signature finish to many junior and senior tournament wins throughout the country.

1989-94 Member of the US Ski Team, won two Junior Olympic titles

1990 Competed with the US Junior World Championship team winning two titles

1991 Won US Junior National Championship
