Born February 8, 1987 in Jacksonville, FL. She attends school at Westminster College, Salt Lake City, UT and makes her home in Park City, UT.

She is a seven times Women's US National Champion, including a sweep of the large and normal hill events in 2008.

Her favorite ski jumping hills are in Norway - Holmenkollen K-115, Lillehammer K-120 and Vikersund K125. Her longest jump was 138 meters, that's nearly one and a half football fields.

- 2005 In eleven LCOC events, finished in top 10 every time, three podium finishes, ranked 5th overall**
- 2006 In eighteen LCOC events, finished in top 10 every time, seven podium finishes, ranked 3rd overall**
- 2007 In a season shortened by injury, competed in eight LCOC events, six top 10 results, two podiums**
- 2008 In sixteen LCOC events, had eight top 10 finishes, one podium, ranked 7th overall**
- 2009 In eighteen LCOC events, had five top 10 finishes, including a pair of 2nd's and a pair of 3rd's; placed 6th in the first ever FIS Women's World Championships in Liberec, CZE**
- 2010 In seventeen LCOC events, had seven top 10 finishes, with four more results in the top 15**
- 2011 Six LCOC top tens in six events, two podium finishes**
