Glenn Kotlarek grew up in one of the ski jumping hot spots in the late 1950 --- Duluth, MN.

He skied under the “pressure” of his older brother, Gene and the guiding hand of his father, George. George and Gene are well known as both are in the American Ski Jumping Hall of Fame in Red Wing, MN and the US Ski & Snowboard Hall of Fame I Ishpeming, MI.

Glenn was quite successful in ski jumping, winning the National Junior Championship in 1959. He had many victories in Men’s classes and culminating with the USA Ski Jumping Masters title in 1975.

Glenn completed his career in ski jumping as the 1980 Head Coach, US Ski Jumping team in the Winter Olympic games in Lake Placid, NY.
